Rachel Freier was elected as a Civil Court Judge in November 2016 and is currently assigned to the New York Criminal Court in Brooklyn. Prior to becoming a judge, she maintained law offices in Borough Park and Monroe, NY, and is licensed to practice in NY, NJ and Washington DC.

Rachel attended Bais Yaakov from elementary school through seminary. After graduating Bais Yaakov, Rachel worked as a legal secretary and then worked her way up to paralegal. Subsequently, Rachel attended Touro College, where she graduated with honors, and then attended Brooklyn Law School part time so that she would have time to study law while raising her six children. She was recently honored as one of Brooklyn Law School's Trailblazers for being the first Chassidic woman to be elected to public office. She has also been involved in numerous causes for charity and public welfare.
